Hot works - Practical Exercises

Duration	3.5 hours
Target group	Personnel performing tasks, such as welding, torch cutting, grinding and roofing, using an open flame.
Prerequisites	This practical module must be completed in the past 24 months, or at least three months after the delegate has passed the theory module.
Objective	In order to safely perform a job using an open flame, you need to have certain knowledge to prevent accidents. The most important thing to learn is which measures need to be in place to prevent fires. The delegate should obtain knowledge about the current regulations surrounding work using an open flame, basic fire theory, and risk associated with the task. This course covers the demands set for the practical part of the training.
Contents	Upon completion of the training, the delegate should master basic skills in extinguishing small fires that can occur during the use of an open flame by: - gaining knowledge of different methods of extinguishing fires, and the necessary equipment, gaining knowledge of routines and behaviour during a fire methods of extuinguishing fires equipment used for extinguishing practical training.
Exam	None. Completed course is valid for 60 months.
