<b>Prerequisites</b>	<p>Smoke Diving basic course.</p> <p>Medical certificate: the delegate should be found physical fit to carry out their tasks.</p> <p>Delegates also need to provide documentation that they have completed and passed the physical tests (test of strenght and fitness test) before they can attend the course.</p> <p>Before the practical part of the course starts, a test will be handed out on the delegate's knowledge and understanding of the NSO's booklets on "Røykdykking og Farlige stoffer-kjemikalievern" and the guidelines by NSO.</p>
