## STCW Safety training for seafarers on smaller ships retraining

---

**Duration** 5h center + 8-10h e-learning

---

**Target group** Seafarers who are to work on board cargo ships with a length of less than 24 meters, less than 500 gross tonnage in a traffic area of small coastal speed or less. The syllabus is based on Rule VI, Section A of the STCW Convention.

NB The course does not give approval to muster on larger convention ships.

---

**Prerequisites** Safety training for seafarers on smaller cargo ships, possibly Basic Safety Training for seafarers, IMO50. 12 months sailing time during the last 5 years.

---

**Objective** Participants will receive training in preventive safety, theoretical and practical sea rescue, first aid, fire theory and firefighting.

---

**Contents** The course contains theoretical preparatory work on e-learning, which must be completed before attending the course centre.

Course content:

- Sea rescue
- Preventive fire protection and firefighting
- Life-saving first aid
- Evacuation, communication

---

**Exam** Written test that requires that 75% of the answers are correct. Passed exam is valid for 60 months.
