## STCW Retraining Coxswain Survival craft and rescue boat 8 h – skid lifeboat

<b>Duration</b>	1 day
<b>Target group</b>	Seafarers (deck and mechanic) in national and international waters. STCW-78 Table A-VI/2-1. The course also covers the guidelines for coxswains on fixed and floating installations given by Norwegian Oil and Gas. After completing the course, delegates can apply for a Certificate of Competency (CoC) with the Norwegian Maritime Authority. Approved according to STCW-78 with Manila 2010 Amendments.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	STCW Coxswain/Rescue Craft 32 hrs.
<b>Objective</b>	Satisfy STWC table A-VI/2-1 Minimum demand for competency for rescue crafts and Man-Over-Board- boats Table A-VI/2 1. Direct, deploy and control boat and equipment.
<b>Contents</b>	Course content: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Organise and direct evacuation from ship with the help of lifeboats.</li><li>- Prepare the lifeboat, organise embarkment, quartering and releasing the boat, manoeuvre and direct operation from the lifeboat while in the water.</li><li>- Methods to start and run the engine with additional equipment on the lifeboat as well as using the fire extinguisher on-board.</li><li>- Methods for rescue by helicopter.</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	Practical test. Written test with multiple-choice answers.
