Emergency Response Teams - Co-ordinated Training -Insident Site Controller

Duration	2 days
Target group	Incident site controllers and other emergency response personnel with responsibilites related to coordination at an incident site.
Prerequisites	Emergency response course
Objective	Upon completion of the course, the delegate should have the knowledge and skill to lead and coordinate available resources at an incident site in an emergency, as well as function as the link between the central emergency response on the installation in order to: - Save and ensure human lives and health. - Limit environmental damage. - Secure material values. - Practice co-ordinated action with their own organisation.
Contents	The course focuses on the leadership role in the emergency response team, and the demands and expectations towards the incident site controller. The course is scheduled with one day of theory, and one day of practical training (possibility of communication exercises). Each delegate will be evaluated and given feedback based on how they master their tasks as incident site controller: - The leadership role - Proactivity - Effective crisis communication - Cooperation on the installation in an emergency situation - Practical leadership of emergency response teams - Co-ordinated training in the emergency response organisation
