<b>Duration</b>	1 day
<b>Target group</b>	Personnel performing tasks which require the use of gear with an open flame.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	None.
<b>Objective</b>	Throughout the course, hot work practitioners will learn what precautions need to be taken to avoid fire, and learn how fire can be stopped quickly if it occurs.
