thorough examination of lifting accessories and manual appliances. The course also covers the preparation of certificates and a series of practical assessments that cover the performance, range statement and knowledge

requirements of national standards of competence. The successful completion of this programme

will provide valuable evidence towards the EAL competence qualification.
