Duration	5 days
Target group	This course is designed for individuals who are most likely to be first on the scene of a medical emergency such as fire fighters or emergency response teams. These persons require specialised knowledge and skills to effectively deal with life threatening situations.
Prerequisites	A valid Advanced First Aid certificate.
