

Safe Confined Space Rescue

Duration	1 day
Target group	This course is designed for persons who are required to enter and work in a confined space and apart of the emergency rescue team.
Prerequisites	A Valid Confined Space Entry Certificate
Objective	This course provides delegates with appropriate knowledge and skills on how to plan and execute a safe and timely rescue in confined spaces.
