## Lifting Operations Planning and Risk Assessment

Duration	1 day
Target group	The course is aimed at personnel who are required to produce and / or authorise lifting plans and carry out lifting operations.
Prerequisites	None required
Objective	This theory-based course is designed to give delegates an understanding of the depth and quality of content required in the production and completion of lifting plans and risk assessments. Note: The course can also be structured to include a practical element if requested.
Contents	The Theoretical and Practical topics covered during this training are: -LOLER Regulation 8   Organisation Of Lifting -Operation -Categorization Of Lifting Operations -Self-Assessment Cards -Lift Description -Weight of The Load -Planning Considerations -Step-By-Step Procedure -Rigging Procedure Diagrams -Route to Be Travelled -Rigging Material Lists -Risk Assessment -Theoretical Planning Exercises Course Handout: The International Rigging & Lifting Handbook.
Exam	Delegates will be assessed against the Learning Outcomes specified in the Content Section using direct observation and oral and/or written questions as appropriate. Delegates will be required to undertake a written test. The pass mark for this course is 80%.
