Advanced First Aid, CPR and AED

Duration	3 days
Target group	This course is designed to train individuals in first aid, CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation), and AED (Automated External Defibrillator). Their role will be to initially evaluate and then stabilize the patient.
Prerequisites	None
Objective	Evaluation and stabilization is a critical time in management of patients, this course is intended to teach the skills necessary for rapid assessment, resuscitation and transportation for someone who has been injured or suddenly ill.
Contents	Participants will undergo theoretical and practical training in Basic Trauma and Life Support on the following subjects. oBackground Information oAction at an Emergency oFinding out what is wrong oBasic Life Support oBleeding & Shock oWounds oDressing & Bandages oBurns oHead & Spinal Injuries oChest, Abdominal, and Pelvic Injuries oBone, joint, and Muscle Injuries oSplinting Extremities oSudden Illness oPoisoning oBites & Stings oCold-Related Emergencies oHeat-Related Emergencies oWilderness First Aid oRescuing & Moving Victims
Exam	Delegates are assessed against relevant agreed competency standards of ECSI. Should delegates fail to meet these standards, RelyOn Nutec shall provide additional coaching to provide the delegate with as much of an opportunity as possible to meet those requirements.
