## Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air

**Duration** 2 hours **Target group** To inform candidates about the procedural and legal requirements for the safe transportation of dangerous goods by air. Note: This course has been written in accordance with Part 1 Chapter 1.4 of the ICAO Technical Instructions for the safe Transport Dangerous Goods by Air and Section 1 Subsection 1.5 of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations. Explain the general philosophy of dangerous goods transportation; 2. Define the limitations on the transportation of dangerous goods by air;3. State the general principles of safe loading and storage of dangerous goods;
7. Explain the requirement for the Pilot's Notification (NOTOC); 8. Explain the provisions for passengers and crew; 9. Explain what to do if an emergency occurs;
