

PST - Personal Survival Techniques (HOUSTM-363)

I.A through 1.14.N inclusive; NVICs 12-14(Ch-3) and 02-18 Task 19.1; and NVIC 13-14(Ch-I) Task 13.1.A.</p> <p>Applicants who have successfully completed your course need not present completed "Task Control Sheets" for these assessments in application for STCW certification.</p>
