

PST - Personal Survival Techniques (HOUSTM-363)

Duration 1.5 days

Target group This 12-hr course (1.5 days) is intended to meet the training requirements established by the standard of competence for basic training as set out in NVIC 08-14 Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-1 of the STCW Code and 46 CFR 11.302(a)(1), 11.302(d)(1) and 46 CFR 12.602(a)(1), 12.602(d)(1).

Prerequisites None

Objective The Personal Survival Techniques standards of competence required by 46 CFR 11.302(a)(1) and 12.602(a)(1); AND The Personal Survival Techniques standards of competence required by STCW Code Section A-VI/1 and Table A-VI/1-1, as amended 2010, meeting the National Assessment Guidelines from NVIC 08-14(Ch-I) Tasks 1. I.A through 1.14.N inclusive; NVICs 12-14(Ch-3) and 02-18 Task 19.1; and NVIC 13-14(Ch-I) Task 13.1.A.

Applicants who have successfully completed your course need not present completed "Task Control Sheets" for these assessments in application for STCW certification.

- Abandonment and Survival
- Types of Lifesaving Appliances Carried on Ships
- Personal Lifesaving Appliances
- Survival Crafts and Survival Crafts Equipment

Exam In order to successfully complete this course, each candidate must obtain a grade percentage of no less than 70% on all examinations. In addition to the written test, the delegate will have to successfully complete a number of hands on and field exercises as defined in the practical section of our submission.
