Target group	<p>Any applicant who has successfully completed your Able Seafarer (National) (HOUSTM-1) course within one year of the date of submitting a complete application will satisfy: The examination and Marlinspike Seamanship demonstration requirements of 46 CFR 12.405 for any national Able Seafarer endorsement.</p> <p>This course does not satisfy any sea service requirements.</p>
Prerequisites	<p>The Code of Federal Regulations 46 CFR 10.403(a)(3) requires training to be administered entirely in the English language unless specifically approved to be presented in another language.</p> <p>Students must be able to read and write in English to take the written exam and successfully complete the course.</p>
Objective	The course covers the knowledge and skill elements required to perform the duties of a certificated Able Seafarer.
