## Liberian Able Seaman Class

<b>Duration</b>	40 hours (5 days)
<b>Target group</b>	There is no written assessment for this course. Delegates will be assessed on performance activities for each learning outcome using direct observation.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	None
<b>Objective</b>	This 40 hour (5 day) course is designed to cover the knowledge and skill elements required to perform the duties of a certified Able Seaman.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>Upon the completion of the course, delegates will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-This course references STCW Code Table A-II/5</li><li>-Keep a proper look-out</li><li>-Steer the ship by compass and comply with helm orders</li><li>-Contribute to the monitoring and controlling of a safe watch</li><li>-Support mooring and anchoring operations</li><li>-Operate cargo and stores equipment</li><li>-Splice and tie line</li><li>-Practice marlinespike seamanship</li><li>-Perform shipboard maintenance and repair</li><li>-Respond to emergencies</li><li>-Apply first aid</li></ul> <p>Follow fuel transfer procedures and prevent pollution Follow health and safety procedures Review Splicing and knot tying assessment</p>
<b>Exam</b>	A closed-book two-part 100-question exam comprised of true/false & multiple choice prompts. Delegates must make a passing score of 70% for each part.
