<b>Duration</b>	1 day
<b>Target group</b>	Construction Industry Workers
<b>Prerequisites</b>	None
<b>Objective</b>	To bring a level of safety awareness to the candidates concerning hazards associated with their work.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>The topics covered during this training are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Introduction to OSHA</li><li>- Fall protection</li><li>- Electrical</li><li>- Caught in/between personal protective and lifesaving equipment</li><li>- Health hazards in construction (including hazard communication)</li><li>- Stairways and ladders</li><li>- Materials handling, storage, use and disposal</li><li>- Tools - hand and power</li><li>- Scaffolds</li><li>- Cranes, derricks, hoists, elevators, &amp; conveyors</li><li>- Excavations</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>The candidate will be required to score a minimum competency of 70% on a written exam.</p> <p>To receive a course completion card, the student must attend the entire class and complete all class requirements, including all requisite topics and the minimum number of contact hours.</p>
