

## CITB Site Safety Plus Health and Safety Awareness

<b>Duration</b>	1 Day
<b>Target group</b>	The CITB Health and Safety Awareness course is for anyone working in the construction industry.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	You must provide valid photographic ID such as a Passport or Driving Licence. Must also have an appropriate level of fluency in English. Course material is also provided. Valid for 5 years.
<b>Objective</b>	This is a mandatory course for any construction civil engineering industry workers. CITB accredited training is designed to make sure workers are aware of dangers and potential risks when working on a construction site. Delegates are required to complete this 1-day course in order to apply for a CSCS Card.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>"Upon completing the health and safety course, delegates will have an awareness of a wide variety of potential hazards and dangers within the construction industry.</p> <p>The course covers the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Their individual responsibilities for their own safety and the safety of others</li><li>•Typical construction hazards and how these are controlled</li><li>•How everyone can help achieve better practical standards of safety on site</li><li>•Legal Requirements and Liabilities</li><li>•Working at Height</li><li>•Manual Handling</li><li>•Fire Prevention</li><li>•Work Equipment</li><li>•Occupational Health "</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	Delegates will complete a written multiple-choice examination at the end of the course. Delegates must then complete the online touchscreen test in order to apply for their CSCS Green Card.
