Highfield Level 3 First Aid at Work

Duration	3 Days
Target group	This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to become emergency first-aiders in the workplace. This qualification meets the requirements for training emergency first-aiders in those organisations that have identified that staff need to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.
Prerequisites	In order to attend this course, delegates must have knowledge of the environment in which the participant performs his or her duties.
Objective	The Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work qualification supports individuals to gain the skills and knowledge to perform First Aid in the workplace. There are no entry requirements for this course. This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to become emergency first-aiders in the workplace. This qualification meets the requirements for training emergency first-aiders in those organisations that have identified that staff need to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.
Contents	The qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider, how to assess an incident and recognising signs and symptoms of injury and illness. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED and assisting a casualty who is suffering from major injury and illness such as chest injuries, spinal injuries, anaphylaxis and correct use of auto-injectors.
