

## Confined Space Medium Risk and Top Person

<b>Duration</b>	2 days
<b>Target group</b>	This is a combined training course for individuals for both Top person and entry into a medium risk confined space, incorporating top person, entry requirements and self-rescue procedures.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	There are no prerequisites for this course.
<b>Objective</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The avoidance of serious injury and major harm to employees and evidence of assessment and qualifications towards competence of employees.</li><li>• Employees who feel they can make a greater contribution to the workplace and who feel their employer has made an investment in their future.</li></ul>
<b>Contents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Risk assessment of confined space hazards.</li><li>• Types of gaseous atmospheres, portable gas monitoring equipment and their use.</li><li>• The use of harness tripod, man-riding winch/fall arrest and safety line, plus the use of escape breathing apparatus as part of a self-rescue procedure.</li><li>• Emergency preparedness and procedures.</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>The theoretical aspects of the course is delivered in the classroom, but there is an emphasis on a hands-on experience with the equipment; tripods, winches/fall arrest retrieval units, harnesses, gas monitors, and escape set breathing apparatus.</p> <p>Assessment focuses on learners planning a confined space entry supervision, entry and undertaking written and oral tests and being observed during practical assessments in order to achieve an accredited certificate.</p>
