Exam Training will consist of a mix of theoretical and practical elements and delegates will have to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of

the course contents.

Upon successful completion of the course, delegates will be awarded an MCA-approved Updated Proficiency in Advanced Fire Fighting certificate. Certification is valid for 5 years at which point delegates should undertake the Updated Proficiency in Advanced Fire Fighting training programme to

remain certified.
