ERRV Fast Rescue Craft Boatman

Duration	3 days
Target group	This OPITO approved programme is designed and specified for Offshore Standby Vessel crew undertaking FRC Boatman duties, with the overall objective of teaching boat handling, rescue and recovery of personnel and casualty care and VHF communications.
Prerequisites	Delegates must have previously attended the Initial Shipboard Operations training (ITSO) and have completed at least 3 months sea-time, with a minimum of 1 month as a SBV crew member.
Objective	The training course consists of multiple elements developed to impart knowledge and understanding and competence to participate as a crew member of a Fast Rescue Craft. Delegates will be continually assessed against defined learning outcomes. Theory 40% Practical 60%
Contents	The course consists of theoretical and practical training required to actively and safely participate as an FRC crew member Assisting in preparing an FRC VHF radio communications Assisting in launching and releasing an FRC Basic boat handling Assisting in rescuing and recovering a casualty Emergency response and self rescue Assisting in recovering an FRC
