Exam	The course is a mix of both practical and theoretical sessions during which delegates will be required to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of the course contents. Upon completion of the course, delegates will be awarded with an OPITO- approved Helideck Emergency Response Team Member (HERTM) certificate Certification is valid for 2 years. Prior to expiry delegates must undertake the Further HERTM course to remain certified.
