<b>Duration</b>	4 Days
<b>Target group</b>	The Basic Offshore Lifeboat Coxswain Initial Training course is for all personnel designated to undertake Offshore Lifeboat Coxswain (Twinfall) duties on an installation survival craft (TEMPSC).
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Delegates must be in possession of a valid Basic Offshore Safety Induction & Emergency Training (BOSIET) certificate or a Further Offshore Emergency Training (FOET) certificate.

Prior to expiry delegates must undertake the Offshore Lifeboat Coxswain (Twinfall) Further Training course to remain certified.</p>
