Exam	<p>The course is a mix of both practical and theoretical sessions during which delegates will be required to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of the course contents.</p> <p>Upon completion of the course, delegates will be awarded with an OPITO-approved Basic Offshore Lifeboat Coxswain (Twinfall) Further Training certificate</p> <p>Certification is valid for 2 years. Prior to expiry delegates must undertake the Basic Offshore Lifeboat Coxswain Further Training course to remain certified.</p>
