IWCF Level 3 Well Intervention Pressure Control with Subsea Module

Duration	5 Days
Target group	Level 3 is designed for experienced single intervention discipline subsea operators.
Prerequisites	The candidate must be pre-registered with IWCF and able to provide his/her 6-digit IWCF Candidate Registration (CR) Number.
Objective	The aim of the IWCF Level 3 course is to develop the candidate's knowledge and understanding of subsea well intervention pressure control. The Level 3 course focuses on the duties and responsibilities of an individual working at operator level.
Contents	The module is delivered through presentation of a series of interactive lectures supported by videos and animations, supplemented by a classroom workbook and further self-study exercises.
Exam	The course includes compulsory training and assessment in Completion Equipment, Completion Operations, Coiled Tubing Operations, Wireline Operations, and Subsea Well Intervention. Successful completion of the course and a pass mark of 70% or above in all IWCF written assessments will result in IWCF Level 3 certification which is valid for two years.
