Actsafes Equipment Lifting Training including ACX Power Ascender

Duration	5 hours
Target group	Any person that will use the ACX ActSafe ascender for lifting of equipment
Prerequisites	Any person attending this training must have a basic Work at Height Certificate
Objective	<p>The purpose of this course is :</p> <p>to provide a thorough introduction with the ACX ascender and getting a good understanding of the function, pre use check and the correct care of the batteries</p> <p>that participants learn how to operate the ACX ascender and familiarize them with the standard equipment lifting setups and their general applications.</p>
Contents	<p>Tell the typical fields of application for ACX ascenders</p> <p>Explain to what ACX ascenders are approved</p> <p>Explain why and when ACX ascenders not must be used</p> <p>Explain the ACX safety guidelines</p> <p>Perform an introduction of an ACX ActSafe ascender and describe all parts and controls and its functions</p> <p>Explain how to take best care of the ACX battery and how they work in relation to the ascender</p> <p>Explain and demonstrate a pre use check of the ascender</p> <p>Explain and demonstrate the starting of the ascender</p> <p>Perform safe and appropriate rigging according to local regulation and best practice</p> <p>Explain and demonstrate correct rope feeding into the ascender</p> <p>Explain and demonstrate safe and correct operation of the ACX ascenders</p> <p>Explain and demonstrate the 4 equipment lifting setups and what are they used for and what the advantages and disadvantages of each particular setup are</p> <p>Demonstrate a change between setups while maintaining a 100% tie off of ascender and equipment</p>
