Prerequisites	Holding an in-date SCO 1 and 2 means an individual is eligible for SCO Renewal modules, module 1: SCO Core, module 2: PtW and module 5: FoA. Holding an in-date SCO 4 means an individual is eligible for SCO Renewal module 3: NRO. Holding an in-date SCO 5 means an individual is eligible for SCO Renewal module 4: RO.
