Each course has relatable, job specific content and the core content is transferable to other industry sectors. | Contents | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understanding of the legal framework surrounding Health and Safety at Work.• An awareness of the Environmental impact of their work.• Identifying hazards and risks at work, both broadly and sector specific.• Awareness of basic processes and procedures in place to work safely and in the event of an emergency. |
