

GWO Enhanced First Aid

Duration	24h – 3 days
Target group	<p>Personnel who will be working in the wind industry or related fields, and who will have duties to fulfil in a wind turbine environment, as well as usually being in physical contact with a wind farm environment or an offshore wind structure.</p> <p>Personnel that is selected by their employer to perform Enhanced First Aid onshore or offshore, where training according to the GWO Enhanced First Aid training may enable them to react to incidents and thus mitigate the results of casualties deriving from the identified risks.</p>
Prerequisites	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Minimum 18 yo- Statement of no health contraindications to participate in the training- WINDA ID number- Working shoes and gloves- Delegates must hold a valid and in-date GWO Enhanced First Aid or Refresher Certificate.
Objective	<p>The EFA Training shall enable Delegates to support and care for others working in the industry by possessing the knowledge, skills and attitude of Enhanced First Aid. Upon completion of the GWO EFA training Delegates will be able to administer safe, effective and immediate lifesaving and enhanced first aid measures to save life and give assistance in remote areas using advanced emergency equipment and medical teleconsultation.</p>

Exam	<p>Certification is valid for 2 years. Prior to expiry delegates must retake GWO Enhanced First Aid Refresher Training to remain certified.</p> <p>Upon completion of the course, delegates will be awarded with GWO approved First Aid Refresher certification.</p>
