

## GWO BST Fire Awareness

<b>Duration</b>	4h – 0,5 day
<b>Target group</b>	Personnel who will be working in the wind industry or related fields, and will carry out their duties in a wind turbine environment, usually in physical contact with a wind turbine or offshore wind structure.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Minimum 18 yo</li><li>- Statement of no health contraindications to participate in the training</li><li>- WINDA ID number</li><li>- Working shoes and gloves</li></ul>
<b>Objective</b>	The aim of GWO Fire Awareness training is to teach delegates to support and care for themselves and others working in the industry by possessing Fire Awareness knowledge and skills.
<b>Contents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Demonstrate knowledge of the development and spread of fire.</li><li>- Demonstrate knowledge of the causes of fires in wind turbines and the dangers related to this.</li><li>- Identify any sign of a fire in a wind turbine environment.</li><li>- Demonstrate knowledge of the contingency plans in a wind turbine environment including smoke detection and emergency escape procedures.</li><li>- Demonstrate correct actions on discovering a fire including correct operation and fire extinguishing by means of the firefighting equipment in a WTG.</li></ul> <p>Course available in Polish/English</p>
<b>Exam</b>	Certification is valid for 2 years. Prior to expiry delegates must retake GWO Fire Awareness Training to remain certified.
