

## IRATA Level 1 Assessment

<b>Duration</b>	8h – 1 day
<b>Target group</b>	All Personnel who wish to operate within the rope access industry.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Medical Questionnaire,</li><li>- 18 years of age.</li></ul>
<b>Objective</b>	<p>IRATA Level 1 will provide knowledge and training in the safe use and inspection of rope access equipment.</p> <p>To be able to complete a range of rope access techniques under the supervision of an IRATA level three.</p>
<b>Contents</b>	<p>Theoretical knowledge of rope access with regard to safe use of equipment and techniques. This will include an understanding of risk assessments and method statements.</p> <p>An understanding and practical application of rigging techniques and appropriate knots. Safely carrying out a range of rope access manoeuvres.</p> <p>Climbing on structures using work positioning and fall arrest techniques.</p> <p>Rescue of an incapacitated rope access worker to ground level.</p>
<b>Exam</b>	Period of valid certification: 3 years
