Objective	Upon successful completion of all training components, in accordance with the Training Standard, trainees will receive a RelyOn Nutec Canada certificate that is valid for three (3) years and a electronic wallet card certificate. The certificate indicates "Aircrew Survival Training with EBS".
Contents	<p>The AST course is designed to provide emergency response training specific for helicopter aircrews transporting workers to offshore vessels and platforms.</p> <p>This course will provide realistic helicopter ditching scenarios that will include both upright surface abandonments and inverted Helicopter Underwater Egress Training (HUET) with and without a compressed air Emergency Breathing System (EBS).</p> <p>In addition, the course will also provide training specific to offshore emergency response procedures and equipment. This includes: offshore hazards introduction; offshore platform abandonment/survival equipment; basic fire extinguisher training with SCBA review; and simulated practical sea survival exercises.</p>
