## Marine Advanced First Aid

<b>Duration</b>	5 days
<b>Target group</b>	Marine/Maritime
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<p>No current prerequisites for this course.</p> <p>ITEMS REQUIRED FOR TRAINING:</p> <p>- When checking in for training, please have your GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO ID with you (ie: Passport or Drivers Licences, etc.)</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: Certificates CANNOT be issued unless valid Government issued ID has been presented on Day 1 of training for all RONC courses, including OPITO approved training.</p>
<b>Objective</b>	Upon successful completion of all training components, in accordance with the Training Standard, trainees will receive a Marine Advance First Aid Training Certificate from St. John Ambulance or Red Cross along with a Transport Canada Training Certificate.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>The Marine Advanced First Aid course includes the use of oxygen, spinal immobilization, and advanced first aid skills, as well as CPR and AED. It is accompanied by a Marine Supplement which includes chapters on marine related topics.</p> <p>This course is approved by Transport Canada and meets the requirements for the Marine Industry.</p>
