<b>Objective</b>	Upon successful completion of all training components, in accordance with the Training Standard, trainees will receive a St. John Ambulance or Red Cross certificate that is valid for three (3) years.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>Courses on cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) provide the skills needed to recognize and respond to cardiovascular emergencies and choking for adults, children, and babies.
