Objective	<p>A comprehensive 'Blended Learning' course (8 hours online learning + 7.5 Hours in-class) offering first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) skills for those who need training due to work requirements or who want more knowledge to respond to emergencies at home.</p> <p>Upon successful completion of all training components, in accordance with the Training Standard, trainees will receive a Red Cross or St. John Ambulance certificate that is valid for three (3) years.</p>
