## CCU's Visual Inspection

<b>Duration</b>	2 Days
<b>Target group</b>	Designed to teach delegates the requirements for safe use of CCU (Cargo Carrying Units) and lifting equipment in an offshore operation. The course covers the use and inspection of lifting equipment in line with LOLER requirements and specifically the requirements for inspection and testing of a CCU with provision of a practical exercise for the delegates.

<b>Objective</b>	<p>Upon completion of the course, the delegate will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•Perform complete pre-use inspections of a CCU, slings, and associated lifting sets.</li><li>•Recognize hazards associated with CCU use</li></ul> <p>NOTE: Delegates will be issued with a RelyOn Nutec certificate to demonstrate successful completion of the course.</p>
