

## Offshore Emergency Response Team Leader (OERTL) Training

<b>Duration</b>	3 days
<b>Target group</b>	This OPITO Approved course is designed for personnel designated as offshore emergency response team leaders on offshore installations.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Delegates attending this programme must possess a valid Offshore Emergency Response Team Member Training (OERTM) certificate
<b>Objective</b>	During the course delegates will learn and demonstrate to a level of competence on how to operate fire-fighting and fire protection equipment and how to deal with various fire situations on-board installations. Emphasis will be on leading and controlling fire / emergency response teams.
