

## IRATA Rope Access Level 2 with Sparrows

<b>Duration</b>	5 Days
<b>Target group</b>	The IRATA Rope Access Level 2 is intended for those who already have the Level 1 certification and wish to progress to become a more advanced and competent rope access technician.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Delegates must have held an IRATA Rope Access level 1 certificate for at least a year and have a minimum of 1,000 hours of experience completed in their logbook.
<b>Objective</b>	The aim of this course is to ensure delegates have the knowledge and skills to work safely and competently undertake more advanced work using rope access.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>By the end of this rope access training programme delegates will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Undertake more complex rescues</li><li>• Perform advanced rope access tasks under supervision</li><li>• Have some knowledge of legislation, safety requirements and quality assurance.</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>An assessment is conducted by an external examiner on the final day. Candidates will receive IRATA Rope Access Level 2 certification on successful completion of the course and assessment.</p> <p>Certification is valid for three years. Candidates can then either undertake the Level 3 course or resit the level 2 course to be recertified.</p>
