## Confined Space Awareness/Entry

<b>Duration</b>	1 day
<b>Target group</b>	This course is designed to provide delegates with an understanding and knowledge of hazards and associated risks for persons required to enter a confined spaces.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<p>ITEMS TO BRING: All delegates must bring Photographic I.D. and PASSPORT only (original or copy)</p> <p>HEALTH: All delegates will be asked to complete a medical questionnaire prior to course commencement.</p>
<b>Objective</b>	The aim and objectives of the Confined Space Awareness / Entry training programme is to ensure that personnel preparing to enter Confined Space are aware of the essential legislation/best working practices and safety requirements for Confined Spaces.
<b>Contents</b>	<p>Delegates will receive theoretical and practical knowledge in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Definition of Confined Spaces</li><li>Hazard Recognition and Assessment</li><li>Atmospheric Hazards</li><li>Physical Hazards</li><li>Code of Practices -Safe Working in Confined Space</li><li>Roles and Responsibilities of Entrants</li><li>Pre -Entry Consideration / Condition of Entry</li><li>Safe Working Procedures</li><li>Confined Space Entry Certificates</li><li>JSA, PTW, Isolation Certificates</li><li>Requirements for PPE and other Associated Equipment</li><li>Emergency and Evacuation Procedures</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	<p>RelyOn Nutec approved certification for Confined Space Awareness/Entry will be issued on successful completion of the training programme.</p> <p>The validity of the certificate is three years.</p> <p>Delegates should report to reception for 08.00hrs, course starts at 08.15hrs, unless otherwise stated.</p>
