## Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats other than Fast Rescue Boats

<b>Duration</b>	4 Days
<b>Target group</b>	This course is designed for all seafarers designated to take charge of a survival craft in an emergency situation. The course covers requirements specified by the IMO STCW95.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	All delegates must be in possession of a valid medical and basic safety certificate. Delegates must have minimum 6 months recorded sea time.
<b>Objective</b>	During the course delegates will demonstrate to a minimum standard of competence set out in STCW 95: Table A-VI/2-1 Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats
