## Basic Banksman / Slinger

**Duration** 2 day This course is aimed at banksman/slingers, crane operators, deck crew, **Target group** roustabouts, drill floor crews and others involved in crane operations. **Prerequisites** Not applicable for this course Objective This course aims to provide delegates with a brief knowledge of legislation applicable when carrying out lifts, including slinging various loads, and all prior assessments related to the risks involved. It also covers communication and basic signals required between the banksman and crane operator. This course combines theory and practical content in accordance with LOLER Regulations
