

Basic Safety Training

Duration	3 days
Target group	Seafarers employed on ships, where they perform operational tasks as part of the crew
Prerequisites	None
Objective	The purpose of this training is to establish maritime authority requirements for the basic course / training in maritime safety, etc. It further aims to meet the requirements for basic safety training as described in the STCW Convention A Code Title VI / 1, paragraph 2, the tables A-VI/1-1, A-VI/1-3 and A-VI/1-4.
Contents	<p>A-VI/1-1 STCW - Personal Survival Techniques</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Various emergencies that may occur (collision, grounding, fire, sinking, etc...) * Various types of rescue equipment that normally exist in ships * Rescue equipment, * Personally rescue equipment placing, * Principals for surviving at sea <p>A-VI/1-3 STCW Elementary First Aid</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Assess the need for help for injured persons and threats to own safety * Have an understanding of body structure and functions, * Have an understanding of initiatives to be implemented immediately in emergencies <p>Ad A-VI/1-4 STCW - Personal safety and social responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Be familiar with emergency plans that will be taken in action during emergencies * Have knowledge of alarm signals and separate duties the crew has been assigned according to the alarm instructions; muster points; proper use of personal safety equipment, * have knowledge of basic procedures for the protection of the environment, * understand the importance of always following safe work procedures, etc.
