<b>Target group</b>	Crew members on board ships who may function as FRB crew.

<b>Prerequisites</b>	Proficiency in Life boats and survival crafts, other than FRB. The participant must have and bring valid maritime health certificate. Officers, able-bodied seaman and mechanics must bring valid examination certificate. Able-bodied seamen must be able to document 6 month sea going experience.

<b>Objective</b>	To give the delegate the knowledge and skills needed to safely crew an FRB. The course is according to STCW-95, table A-VI/2-2.

<b>Contents</b>	<p>Delegates will undergo practical and theoretical training in the following subjects</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Construction and outfit of FRBs and individual items of their equipment</li><li>Particular characteristics and facilities of FRBs</li><li>Safety precautions during launch and recovery of an FRB</li><li>Capsizing and procedures for righting a capsized FRB</li><li>How to handle and FRB in prevailing and adverse weather and sea conditions</li><li>Navigational and safety equipment available in an FRB</li><li>Search patterns and environmental factors affecting their execution</li><li>Assessment of the readiness of FRBs and related equipment for immediate use</li><li>Knowledge of the maintenance, emergency repairs, normal inflation and deflation of buoyancy compartments of inflated FRBs</li><li>Methods of starting and operating an FRB engine and its accessories</li><li>Manage injured persons, including the control of bleeding and shock</li></ul> <p>THE COURSE IS CONDUCTED AS A COMBINATION COURSE WITH OTHER BOAT COURSES</p>
