Those jurisdictions include the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Wake Island, Johnston Island, and the Outer Continental Shelf Lands as defined in the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act.</p> <p>Millions of workplace incidents occur every year, and almost all are preventable. Understanding the causes of incidents, following safety procedures, identifying hazardous conditions, and using Stop Work Authority all help to minimize incidents and protect life, health and property.</p>
