Those jurisdictions include the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Wake Island, Johnston Island, and the Outer Continental Shelf Lands as defined in the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act.</p> <p>Slips, trips, and falls can happen anywhere on the work site, and constitute the majority of all general industry accidents. By following safe work practices and taking preventative measures, workers can reduce the risk of injury from slip, trip, and fall hazards.</p>
