STCW Safety training for seafarers on smaller ships retraining

Duration	5h center + 8-10h e-learning
Target group	<p>Seafarers who are to work on board cargo ships with a length of less than 24 meters, less than 500 gross tonnage in a traffic area of small coastal speed or less. The syllabus is based on Rule VI, Section A of the STCW Convention.</p> <p>NB The course does not give approval to muster on larger convention ships.</p>
Prerequisites	Safety training for seafarers on smaller cargo ships, possibly Basic Safety Training for seafarers, IMO50. 12 months sailing time during the last 5 years.
Objective	Participants will receive training in preventive safety, theoretical and practical sea rescue, first aid, fire theory and firefighting.
Contents	<p>The course contains theoretical preparatory work on e-learning, which must be completed before attending the course centre.</p> <p>Course content:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Sea rescue- Preventive fire protection and firefighting- Life-saving first aid- Evacuation, communication
Exam	Written test that requires that 75% of the answers are correct. Passed exam is valid for 60 months.
