## STCW Medical First Aid

<b>Duration</b>	3 days
<b>Target group</b>	Medical First Aid for officers, as well as medical first aid emergency personnel on-board.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Basic safety training. Officers also need the advanced safety training for seafarers.
<b>Objective</b>	The course aims to provide the knowledge and skills needed to perform best when accidents occur on-board. The course is built on STCW table A-VI/4-1 Medical First Aid. Approved by STCW-78 with the Manila 2010 amendment.
<b>Contents</b>	The course covers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Practical first aid exercise with markers.</li><li>- Life saving first aid.</li><li>- Treatment of injuries</li><li>- CPR</li><li>- Nursing</li><li>- Acute illness</li><li>- Burns</li><li>- Broken bones</li><li>- Head, neck and back injuries</li><li>- Psychological/psychiatric challenges on-board</li><li>- Radio Medico</li><li>- Medical emergency</li><li>- Toxic dangers on-board</li></ul>
<b>Exam</b>	Written test with multiple-choice answers. Your practical skills will be evaluated individually according to the competency demands set out in STCW.
