Crisis Management - Refresher

Duration 1 day

Target group Personnel who are to perform emergency response leadership on an operative level (line 1 and line 2)

The course is aimed at all personell who are part of the organization's emergency management offshore and onshore, including key personell such as:

- Injury site leader
- Nurse
- Control room operator
- Air and maritime operators
- Radio operator
- Officers on emergency response vessels

Prerequisites Crisis management, basic course

Objective Repetition of main principles in emergency response leadership and organisation of emergency response teams:

- Application of the working method proactive leadership
- Coordination/collaboration with internal/ external units in an emergency situation
- Co-operation, communication and leadership
- Exercises and training in decision-making

Contents Lectures will be held on different aspects concerning the establishment of emergency response activities. The main part of the course is presented through various exercises focusing on communication and decision-making.
