Search and Rescue Basic

Duration	5 days
Target group	Emergency team personnel on fixed and mobile facilities on the Norwegian Continental Shelf.
Prerequisites	Valid Basic Safety Training approved by Norwegian Oil and Gas (NOROG). All delegates must present a medical certificate for personnel performing search and rescue duties. Delegates must also pass the fitness test and test of strenght before course start.
Objective	After completing the course the participants should be able to: - conduct search and rescue operations - planning and implement fire-fighting measures - taking action to prevent the spread of fires - complete risk assessments - know the limitations of equipment and personnel
Contents	During the course, the following topics are covered: - Emergency preparedness/organisation - Lifesaving first aid - Patient examination/triage - Fire theory - Substances used for fire extinguishing - Fire extinguishing equipment - Fire extinguishing and fire suppression - Physiology - Compressed air and other smoke diving equipment - Search and rescue incl. smoke diving - Pressurized gases and fluids (deluge in the event of a gas leak) - Mental reactions and psychological stress management (in the event of accidents and catastrophes) - Rescue work at damage site.
